#### The Turtle-Flambeau Waters

Pure, sparkling water - nearly 19,000 acres of it for you to use and enjoy in a variety of ways. The Turtle-Flambeau Flowage is a result of the 1926 construction of a dam to create a reservoir. The Turtle-Flambeau Dam harnesses the power of the Turtle and Flambeau rivers and created 18,900 acres of water with 212 miles of winding shoreline, 95% of which are publicly owned. The Flowage encompasses nine lakes, three rivers and several creeks, all beautifully free of pollution.

The Turtle-Flambeau Flowage invites anglers to enjoy the solitude of a vast wilderness to pursue their limit of walleye, musky, bass and panfish. The pristine rapids of the Flambeau River offer a more adventurous angling experience while calm area streams beckon to trout devotees.

#### **Outstanding Area for Nature Lovers**

Designated as a protected wilderness area, the Turtle Flambeau Flowage is truly a water wonderland, offering countless opportunities for swimming, canoeing, kayaking and boating. A 26-mile boat, canoe or kayak trip on the North Fork of the famous Flambeau River, from the Flowage to the city of Park Falls, traverses 23 rapids, providing adventurous visitors with plenty of whitewater thrills. We remind everyone to keep the area in its pristine state for those who come later - if you pack it in, please pack it out.







Snowmobile, Snowshoe, Ski & Ice Fish

This area is noted for its heavy snowfall, which comes early and stays late each year. Iron County has over 325 miles of marked and maintained snowmobile trails, and area businesses cater to winter sports enthusiasts. These businesses are marked with a symbol of a snowmobiler in their ads below. Other popular ways to enjoy our generous snowfall are cross country skiing and snowshoeing trek into the solitude of tall balsam forests to enjoy beautiful scenery and winter wildlife.

Of course, with all the water here, ice fishing has blossomed into one of our favorite winter pastimes. Winter panfishing on the clean waters of the Flowage produces some of the finest eating you will ever enjoy.



#### Wildlife and Beautiful Scenery


